Event Sponsorship

The Campaign for the Fair Sentencing of Youth (CFSY) invites you to sponsor an immersive, paradigm-shifting experience this fall. In September, we will gather corporate partners, key stakeholders, and members of the Incarcerated Children's Advocacy Network (ICAN), as well as survivors of violence, for a two-day proximity gathering in historic Montgomery, AL.

Your sponsorship bolsters our Community Prosperity Initiative (CPI) – a national social justice strategy aimed at supporting the full reintegration of people who were sentenced to life in prison without parole as children and are now returning home to their communities. CPI partners support a range of collaborations and projects, including (but not limited to) Fair Chance Hiring initiatives, skill development and mentorship programs, and contributions of "welcome home resources" like grocery gift cards and transportation vouchers. In partnership with the CFSY, CPI partners provide transformative support that eliminates barriers to securing and sustaining basic resources (living wage employment, housing, and transportation) that many ICAN members face upon their release from prison.
